## **De La Senne Taras Boulba**

**4.5% 33cl £4**

A world-class hoppy pale ale from one of Belgium's best craft breweries. Fruity and endlessly sippable.

## **Paulaner Munich Lager**

**4.9% 50cl £4**

Classic Helles lager from its birthplace. Smooth, clean and plenty of biscuit malt.

## **Ayinger Bavarian Pils**

**5.0% 33cl £4.00**

The glossy, light yellow Ayinger Bairisch Pils is highly fermented and therefore slim in the taste, but also mild and flavourful in the body.

## **Rothaus Tannazapfle Pils**

**5.1% 33cl £4**

The absolute classic amount Rothaus beers and has been since 1956. The best aroma hops from Tettngang and Hallertau, local malt made from barley from the Black Forest give this beer its uniquely spicy and fresh taste.

## **Vedett Extra Pilsner**

**5% 33cl £4**

A delicious Belgian pilsner from one of Belgium's most forward thinking family breweries. Lemony and refreshing,

## **Brugse Zot Blonde**

**6% 33cl £4**

A staple of any decent Belgium fridge, a nice low abv blonde with plenty of caramel and spice.



## **Bolleke De Koninck**

**5.2% 33cl £4.50**

A rare session beer from Belgium, De Koninck is a carmael-tinged Belgian amber with soft hoppy notes.

## **Schlenkerla Lager Helles**

**4.3% 50cl £4.50**

A unique helles lager fermented with the same yeast used with the smoked beer for subtle smokiness

## **Westmalle Extra**

**4.8% 33cl £5**

A bit of a rarity in the UK, a lower abv Trappist beer that the brewers make for themselves.

## **Augustiner Helles**

**5.2% 50cl £5**

Another classic from Munich, a bit more piney and resinous on the nose.

## **Andechs Weisse Hell**

**5.5% 50cl £5**

It's a delicious. Smooth wheat beer made by one of Bavaria's best loved breweries.

## **Delirium Tremes**

**8% 33cl £5.50**

Very well-known blonde from Belgium, one for the end of the evening.

### **Burning Sky Arise Pale**

4.4% 44cl £5.50

This is an excellent pale ale from Sussex, plenty of bitterness balanced with citrusy hop notes.

### **Trappiste Rochefort 8**

9.2% 33cl. £5.50

Another Belgium beer this time with a rich malt balanced with yeast esters, a bit indulgent.

### **Tiny Rebel Clwb Tropica**

0.5% 33cl. £2.50

This is what happens when you slice pineapples, squeeze mangos, crush peaches and pummel passionfruit into a Non-Alc IPA.

### **Jupiler Pils**

0.0% 25cl. £2.00

One of the world's best low alcohol lagers, Jupiler low alcohol is a Belgian pilsner that is alcohol free.
